The job security of the membership, as a whole, demands a level of uncompromised trade union solidarity and a collective withholding of our valuable, skilled labour from those employers who are not willing to abide by the provisions of our collective agreements.

If you are a UA member at this site, employed by CLAC or any other non-signatory contractor, you are in violation of the UA Constitution. You will be charged and may face expulsion if found guilty.

Currently, there are calls locally and open calls for our trades on union projects.
