Advocacy:

If you are having difficulties accessing information from the Employment Insurance Program, we can assist you in finding out information regarding your claim for benefits.

Appeals:

If you have a decision of the Employment Insurance Program which affects you negatively, we can assist you with representation at an appeal.

Referrals:

If you need other assistance, we can refer you to other organizations which could be of assistance to you.

If you need assistance with your Employment Insurance call, the Unemployed Workers Help Centre near you. The Centres are open 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
